The dove, for me, represents peace, and my name Irene represents peace.



He wrote these words on his death bed, surrounded by his brother friars 'I have done what is mine to do, now you do what is yours'.






## Aruna Nagar

**Indira**


This is a religious symbol from the Hindu faith.
